ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The SuperSail XXXVII Regatta is organized by the Winnetka Yacht Club, Winnetka, Illinois.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2009-2012, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The organizing authority is the Winnetka Yacht Club 1.3 The Regatta is designated Category C in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.

2. CLASSES

3. ELIGIBILITY

This is an open regatta. All yachts of the participating classes are welcome, with the following provisions:

3.1 This regatta is in the Area K Laser series.

4. ENTRIES and FEES

Eligible boats are entered upon completion of the registration forms, signing of all waivers, payment of the regatta fee, and check-in at the regatta. The fee must be mailed with checks made payable to: Winnetka Yacht Club, P. O. Box 75, Winnetka, IL 60093. Fees must be postmarked by July 5 in order to avoid a \$20 late fee.

4.1 The entry fee is:

a. \$55 for Optimist, Laser, Laser Radial, Bug Jr.

b. \$75 for Club 420, Vanguard V-15

c. Entry fee includes registration, Breakfast, Lunch on the water Sat and post sailing, Sunday lunch for Helm and Crew.

d. U.S. Sailing Members in good standing can deduct \$5 from the fee.

f. A \$20 late Registration fee will be added for registrations received after July 5, 2009.

g. The Club 420 Racing Clinic; \$85, \$75 for all Club 420 members in good standing

h. The Opti racing Clinic; \$50

4.2 Support boats and Coaching boats are permitted on the water but must register and attend mandatory meetings for instructions.

6. SAFETY and Risk

6.1 All boats must be in sound condition and be equipped in accordance with their class rules and the RRS as well as federal and state regulations. It is the responsibility of each skipper (or parent for minor skipper/crews) to assess their ability, their crew, & their boat to safely compete in the weather conditions as they exist.

6.2 It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors (or their parents for minor skipper/crews) are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7. Waiver

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers including the Winnetka Yacht Club, the Winnetka Park District, the race committee, protest committee, judges or any other associated organization or official will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By

participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

8. MEALS

Meals will be included in the regatta fee this year. Additional meals will also be available to friends and guests but must be ordered with registration or at check-in. Water and soft drinks will be provided.

9. PRIZES

Low point scoring (RRS App-A) will be in effect. Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each class. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Regatta Committee.

10. OVERNIGHT STORAGE

All boats may be stored on the beach and pier area overnight. The park gates will be locked overnight. Please note however, that the Winnetka Yacht Club and the Winnetka Park District will not be responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items and/or boats.

11. DIRECTIONS

From the North: I-94 east to Tower Road. East on Tower Road 2.3 mi to end (Sheridan). South on Sheridan .1 mi to Lloyd Park entrance.

From the South and East: I-94 west to Willow Road. East on Willow .8 mi to Hibbard Road. North 1.0 mi on Hibbard to end (Tower). East on Tower .9 mi to end (Sheridan). South on Sheridan .1 mi to Lloyd Park entrance.

From the Southwest: I-294 north to Willow Road. East 6.0 mi to Hibbard Road. North 1.0 mi on Hibbard to end (Tower). East on Tower .9 mi to end (Sheridan). South on Sheridan .1 mi to Lloyd Park entrance.

Once inside Lloyd Park, check-in and launching area is at the bottom of the hill; parking at the top.
